

Attachment Focused Therapy Services

Our Attachment Focused Therapy program employs highly experienced therapists to work with families through emotions and behaviors surrounding issues such as: grief and loss, identity, family adjustment, abandonment, etc. Our services are family and relationship focused and build on a family's strengths.

Therapists receive extensive training in attachment, Trauma Informed Care and other adoption specific issues. Counseling services empower families regardless of where they are on their journey. Attachment Focused Therapy is beneficial to all families, not just those in crisis.
