



Preventive Services

Flanner House of Indianapolis, Inc., a 501(c) (3) charitable organization mission is to support, advocate for and empower individuals, children and families by applying educational, social and economic resources that move the community towards self-sufficiency. With 123-years of rich legacy, Flanner House has maintained to be a pillar for the community. Flanner House desires to provide clients access to a full range of essential economic supports in a convenient location to help families build self-sufficiency, stabilize their finances, and move ahead. Flanner House currently has the following programs that are offered to the community: Early Childhood Education (Level 4 Pathways to Quality) for low income working families children; infants – 5 years of age through our Childhood Development Center, Before and After youth program for the ages of 5-16, Summer Youth Program 12-22, The Center for Working Families(CWF) and Skills To Success(job readiness program) provides Financial Literacy, Education, Trainings and Workforce Development activities and self-sufficiency support; Senior Services which reduce isolation, provide wellness education/assessments and increase mobility through age appropriate exercise, Food Justice-F.E.E.D (Farming, Education, Employment and Distribution) an innovative approach to skill development and employment preparation services for youth and young adults(16-24 vulnerable youth, who have dropped out of school, have barriers that are hindering them from moving forward in life) which facilitates transition to career pathway and self-sufficiency while simultaneously addressing the issue of food insecurity. The geographic location is 24th and Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Street. The area that is typically served is bounded by 38th Street on the north, Capital Ave. on the east, Washington Street on the south, and White River on the west (46208 along with the overlapping area of 46205). For the majority of our services this is the “catchment” area we serve (within 46208), with the exception of our Senior’s program and the CWF/Skills to Success/Food Justice program, which utilize the majority of Marion County.

Services being providing:

- Provide families, children and youth with preventive sessions and activities along with case-management/counseling through our Social Services and Center for Working Families providing employment, financial coaching and therapy sessions
- Health and Wellness (exercising, healthy eating), Toxic Stress (manage stress through meditation/yoga, coloring), Life Skills (self-esteem, positive thinking)
- Bookstore (Ujamaa) onsite provides literacy programming along with family programming and activities.
- Food Justice children and youth will be offered farm work experience at Flanner House urban farm (to work and understand how healthy foods are grown)
